



Horace Johnny Farrack

April 4, 1942 - August 1, 2016

Funeral services for Horace Farrack, 74 of Giddings, are scheduled for 10:00 am on Thursday, August 4, 2016 at Holy Trinity Lutheran Church in Fedor, Texas with Rev. Jonathan Meyer officiating. Burial, with military honors provided by the Giddings American Legion York Post 276, will immediately follow in the church cemetery. Visitation will be held on Wednesday, August 3, 2016 from 10:00 am until 9:00 pm and on Thursday, August 4, 2016 from 7:00 am until 8:00 am at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. Family will be present from 5:00 pm until 8:00 pm Wednesday evening at the funeral home.

Horace Johnny Farrack was born on April 4, 1942 in Temple, Texas, the son of Ernest Alfred Sr. and Ella Otilie (Hanusch) Farrack. He was baptized on May 17, 1942 at Zion Lutheran Church in Walburg by Rev. J.H. Kollmeyer. He was confirmed on April 15, 1956 at Zion Lutheran Church in Walburg by Rev. Walter Bielefeldt. His confirmation verse was Psalm 37:4, "Delight yourself in the Lord, and he shall give thee the desires of thine heart." He was united in marriage to Elvira Schubert on September 26, 1964 at Holy Trinity Lutheran Church in Fedor by Rev. Andrew Szegedin. This union was blessed by one daughter, Diana. In 1961, Horace enlisted in the U.S. Army and was moved to the Army Reserve for several years. Horace was a member of the Giddings American Legion York Post 276 where he served as Vice Commander and Service Officer for 25 years. He enjoyed serving fellow Veterans. Horace held

membership in the Texas Cattleman's Association and the Paint Creek Wildlife Association. He served Hope Lutheran Church in Austin as a Trustee and usher for 30 years, and also served as a usher and a voting member at Holy Trinity Lutheran Church in Fedor. Horace loved polka music, gardening, fishing, attending his granddaughter's softball and volleyball games, talking about family history and attending family reunions.

Horace passed away the morning of Monday, August 1, 2016 at his residence in Giddings.

He is preceded in death by his parents; parents in law, Alma & Otto Schubert; two brothers, August Alfred Farrack and Monroe Charles Farrack; one sister, Franice Ann Farrack; three brothers-in-law, Walter Randig Sr., Herbert Schubert, and Victor Schubert, and one sister-in-law, Ruth Schubert.

Horace is survived by his wife of 51 years, Elvira Farrack of Giddings; one daughter, Diana and her husband, Dwayne Schulze of Paige; one granddaughter, Emily Schulze of Paige; Brother, Ernest and his wife, Sara Farrack of Walburg; one sister, Marie Randig of Manor; two brothers in law, Ray Schubert and his wife, Carolyn, and Martin Schubert and his wife, Julie; three sisters in law, Helen Marx and her husband, Clarence, Alda Bess Schubert, and Mary Schubert, as well as numerous nieces and nephews.

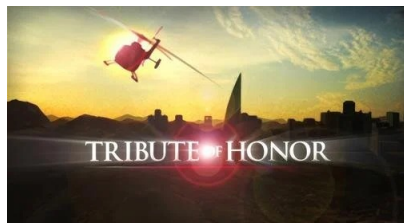

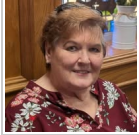
