



Howard John Boriack

Funeral services for Howard Boriack, 76 of Lincoln, Texas, are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, July 19, 2011 at St. John Lutheran Church in Lincoln, Texas with Rev. Dale Bohm officiating. Burial will follow in the church cemetery. The Boriack family will be present for visitation Monday evening from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. Howard passed away peacefully into the loving arms of His Lord and Savior on Friday evening, July 15, 2011 at Richards Memorial Hospital in Rockdale, Texas. Howard John Boriack was born on February 24, 1935 to Charles and Ida (Umlang) Boriack at Lincoln, Texas. He was baptized on March 3, 1935 at St. John Lutheran Church in Lincoln by Rev. A. Osthoff and confirmed there on April 10, 1949 by Rev. H.A. Stroebel. He married Frieda Schneider on November 21, 1954 at Trinity Lutheran Church in Fedor, Texas. They first lived at Lincoln where he helped on the family farm. In 1958, the family moved to Austin where Howard worked for Superior Dairies and Snap-On Tools; then in 1963 returned to Lincoln to do dirt work. The business grew to a climax during the 1970's oil boom and included contract dirt work around the state. He was a director of Conservation Contractors of Texas for many years. Howard was a faithful church member and served in various positions in the congregation of St. John Lutheran Church of Lincoln. His last years were spent at home in the loving care of his wife, Frieda. Howard was preceded in death by his parents;
