Howard Samuel Drummond of Rockdale, passed away on Wednesday, October 5, 2016. Funeral services will be held at 11:00 am, Saturday, October 8, 2016 at Forest Grove Christian Church near Rockdale with Pastor Lance Walch officiating. Burial with Masonic Rites will be held following the service at Forest Grove Cemetery. Visitation with family and friends will be held Friday, October 7, 2016 at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Rockdale from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm.

Howard Samuel Drummond was born into the loving marriage of Curtis Samuel Drummond and Olga Theresa Gicklhorn-Drummond on March 18, 1939, in Thorndale, Texas. He married the love of his life, Carolyn Ann Young on September 2, 1962, in Rockdale at First Christian Church.

Mr. Drummond was a proud graduate of Thorndale High School and Austin Barber College. While at Thorndale High School he excelled in both academics and sports. In elementary school, he began his career working at C. A. Forbes where he stood on an apple box and dipped ice cream and continued to work there for many years. After graduation from barber school, he purchased Jerry's Barber Shop in Rockdale. Cutting hair was a passion. Later he sought employment at Industrial Generating Company (IGC). While at IGC he was a heavy equipment operator, union president and much more. Later he was hired by Alcoa Sandow Mine. Mr. Drummond loved his job and

especially the people that worked with him. He retired from Alcoa Sandow Mine after 37 years of service. He held various positions in the mines such as Safety Coordinator and Area Supervisor.

Mr. Drummond was a proud member of Forest Grove Christian Church and the Masonic Lodge #414. He held a 32nd Degree Scottish Rite of Free Masonry in the Valley of Austin Orient of Texas. Mr. Drummond was a 50 plus year member of the Masonic Lodge. He served in the Texas National Guard during the Cuban Missile Crisis as a member of the 49th 3rd Med Tank Battalion.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Curtis and Olga Drummond and older brother Melton C. Drummond.

Mr. Drummond is survived by his loving wife of 54 years, Carolyn; their daughter, Dee Ann Drummond-Estlack and her husband Larry Estlack; his brother-in-law, Lee Young; his sister, Margie Drummond-Massar; and numerous cousins, nieces, nephews.

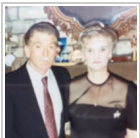
