Hubert Lee Caywood was a lifelong resident of Milam County and the Rockdale area, living the past 38 years in Minerva. He was born October 27, 1920 in Talbot Ridge Community near Rockdale to Albert Lee and Fannie Myrtle (Martin) Caywood. He attended school at Talbot Ridge and graduated from Rockdale High School in 1938. On July 19, 1941 he married the love of his life, Wanda Lucille Rutherford in Rockdale. He was inducted into the U.S. Navy in June of 1943 and was honorably discharged as a Seaman First Class in November of 1945. Hubert was a rancher and had worked for Alcoa as a head tapper for many years and then worked in the yard service. He retired in 1983. He was a long time member of Murray Street Church of Christ in Rockdale. He enjoyed hunting, fishing, gardening, reading western books, and picking pecans and berries.

Hubert passed away Thursday, November 6, 2014 in the Cameron Nursing

Home. He was preceded in death by his beloved wife, Wanda on August 23, 2011; their son Brent Caywood on January 22, 2001; a brother, Herbert “Spud” Caywood; and three sisters, Bertha Williams, Ella Caywood and Ivy Laurence.
