Private Interment at Providence Cemetery. Mrs. Emerson died peacefully on Saturday, April 7, 2012 at St. Joseph Manor in Bryan. Inez was born November 17, 1921 to Jesse A. Hitchcock and Elenora Phillips Hitchcock in the Providence Community of Burleson County, Texas. She was the third of seven children. After graduating from Caldwell High School she moved to Houston, Texas to find employment. She worked at several jobs and then to further her education she enrolled in the American Business Institute. Upon completion of the business school she took a records clerk position with the Baker & Botts Law Firm in Houston where she was employed for twenty-five (25) years. On June 7, 1947 she married Ernest W. Emerson in Houston, Texas where they resided until their retirement in 1978. For 61 years, she and "Ernie" were devoted to each other and it was evident to all who knew them. Together, they were actively involved in the teaching ministry in various churches in the Houston area and continued to work in the ministry after retirement. She was an excellent seamstress and homemaker and was known for her happy disposition. She placed her life in the hands of the Lord and trusted Him, even in the smallest things. She is preceded in death by her parents; husband "Ernie" on 11-17-2008 and two brothers, Howard G. Hitchcock and Philip F. Hitchcock.
