Ira Judson Lehmann was born on February 26, 1924 in Ledbetter, Texas to Martin & LaVina (Gantt) Lehmann. He was a veteran who served in the Pacific in the Army Infantry as a rifleman. He was united in marriage to Joyce Sommer on September 7, 1947 at Martin Luther Lutheran Church in Carmine, Texas by Rev. Leo Simon. Ira was baptized and confirmed on December 20, 1949 at Martin Luther Lutheran Church in Carmine by Rev. A.T. Kluge. He was a lifelong farmer and rancher who owned and operated his own soil conservation and land management service for many years. Ira also worked on one of the first oil well drilling rigs in Lee County. He was a member of the Ledbetter Volunteer Fire Department and a member of Martin Luther Lutheran Church in Carmine where he had served on the church council and on the building committee. Ira and Joyce enjoyed traveling and dancing for many years. He was always a hard worker who still enjoyed taking time out to

spend with his family and watch his grandchildren play. He was preceded in death by his parents, Martin & LaVina Lehmann; his son, Judson Lehmann; his son-in-law, David Dyess; four brothers, Randolph, Chester, Clarence and Dewitt Lehmann and a sister, Lily Schiege.
