Burial will follow in the church cemetery. Irene Helen (Berger) Noack was born on February 17, 1937 in Giddings, Texas to Walter and Minna (Biehle) Berger. She was baptized on February 28, 1937 by Rev. G.W. Fischer at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings. Irene was confirmed on March 18, 1951 by Rev. Max Studtmann at Immanuel. Her confirmation verse was Galatians 2:20, "I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me." She was united in marriage to Clarence Herman Noack on November 21, 1954 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin by Rev. Arthur Arndt. They were blessed with four children. Irene worked as a cook at St. Paul Lutheran School in Serbin and the Immanuel Lutheran Early Childhood Center for many years. She was an active member of St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin where she had been a member of the Ladies Aid, was a member of the Giddings Red Hat Society, and volunteered with Rejuvenation.

She enjoyed reading, crossword puzzles and word searches. She was always on the go whether it was shopping trips, eating out or visiting with family and friends. Irene loved her animals especially her dog, Queen and even named every single head of cattle she had. More than anything, Irene loved her family, especially her grandchildren. They fondly remember the annual weeklong trip of all nine of them staying at her house during Vacation Bible School at St. Paul Lutheran in Serbin.

Irene passed away the morning of Thursday, June 1, 2023 in La Grange.
