Irene Gladys Wagner Boriack Schneider was born on September 4, 1930, in Manheim, Texas, to Alvin Wagner and Ester (Nitsche) Wagner. She was baptized in Manheim, on September 21, 1930. She only completed a 6th grade education because she cared for her ill mother, helped her Dad on the farm and cared for her 3 younger siblings. This is where she learned her unending work ethics. She was confirmed in Lincoln, on April 9, 1944. She married her first husband Martin Robert Boriack, on May 15, 1949, at St. John Lutheran Church. Together they had three children, Leonard, Larry, and Delbert. After her first husband's death she waited 42 years to marry her second husband, Albert Edmund Schneider on February 14, 2011, at Martin Luther Lutheran Church.

Irene's livelihood was taking care of her cattle and chickens. She was the

former cook for the Giddings High School, which she enjoyed very much. She enjoyed driving around the farm, working the land, gardening and tending her flowers. Her hobbies included playing 42 and solitaire, as well as traveling. She was known for her coffee cakes and her wonderful meals, but most of all she loved spending time with her loving family and especially the grandchildren and great grandchildren. She was part of a few organizations such as the Ladies Aid group at St. John Lutheran Church and Immanuel Lutheran Church, Braille, Rejuvenation Shop in Giddings, Wendish Heritage Museum (making noodles and cooking for the tourists) and the American Legion.

Irene passed away the afternoon of Thursday, April 23, 2026, at Towers Nursing Home in Smithville, Texas.

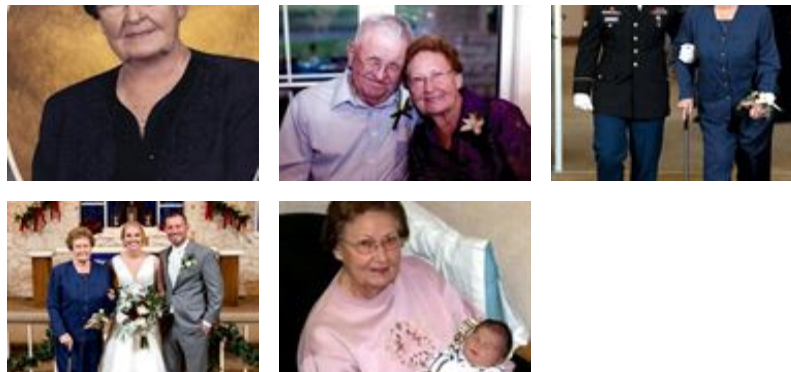

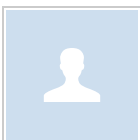

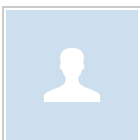
