September 6, 1919 - December 22, 2015

Funeral services for Irene Wright, 96 of Ledbetter, Texas, are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Monday, December 28, 2015 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin, Texas with Rev. John Schmidt officiating. Burial will immediately follow in the church cemetery. Visitation will be held on Sunday, December 27, 2015 from 9:00 a.m. until 9:00 p.m. and on Monday, December 28, 2015 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:30 a.m. at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. Irene Louise (Walther) Wright was born on September 6, 1919 in Warda, Texas to Alwin Karl Walther and Hulda Theresa (Driessner) Walther. She was baptized on September 14, 1919 at Holy Cross Lutheran Church in Warda by Rev. Gottfried Buchschacher and confirmed on April 17, 1932 at Bethany Lutheran Church in Greens Creek, Texas by Rev. Paul C. Eifert. Her confirmation verse was 1 Timothy 1:15, "This is a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners; of whom I am chief". Irene was united in marriage to John Wilson Wright on August 11, 1942 in Galveston, Texas by Galveston County Judge E.B. Homan. They lived in Houston for many years before moving to Ledbetter in 1975. Irene had been a member of St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin since 1972. She enjoyed baking, gardening and canning and enjoyed sharing these with others. Irene was extremely talented and was able to do almost anything and everything that she put her mind to do.

Irene passed away the evening of Tuesday, December 22, 2015 at St. Mark's Medical Center in La Grange.
