



Iris Henderson Bohr

August 19, 1937 - September 15, 2025

Graveside services for Iris Bohr, 88, of Austin, Texas, are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, September 20, 2025 at the Giddings City Cemetery in Giddings. Military honors will be provided by the Giddings American Legion York Post 276.

Iris Henderson Bohr was born on August 19, 1937, near Giddings, Texas, the daughter of Robert David Henderson and Theresa Esther (Blasig) Henderson. She was baptized on September 5, 1937, at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin, Texas by Rev. Herman Schmidt and confirmed on March 18, 1951, at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings by Rev. Max Studtmann. Her confirmation verse was 1 Peter 5:10-11, "And the God of all grace, who called you to his eternal glory in Christ, after you have suffered a little while, will himself restore you and make you strong, firm and steadfast". Iris attended grade school at Immanuel Lutheran School in Giddings and graduated as the valedictorian from Giddings High School in 1955. She eventually received her Master's Degree in Education. Iris joined the United States Air Force on August 17, 1964, and served during Vietnam. She received her Honorable Discharge on July 24, 1967, having obtained the rank of 1st Lieutenant. Iris taught briefly at Immanuel Lutheran School in Giddings and at Giddings I.S.D. before joining the Texas Youth Commission in Giddings as a teacher at the Giddings State School. After retiring from the Texas Youth Commission, she worked in curriculum development with the Texas Education Agency in Austin.

Iris was the type of person who wanted to take care of everyone she knew and everything she came in contact with. She was an excellent gardener tending to her potted plants, roses and flowers. She enjoyed crocheting, line dancing and playing cards and games, especially Bridge and Canasta. She will be remembered for her generosity and being one of the sweetest and kindest people you would have ever had the opportunity to meet.

Iris passed away the morning of Monday, September 15, 2025, surrounded by her family, at Beacon Hospice in Austin.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Robert & Theresa Henderson; her brother, Roy Henderson; her brother-in-law, Dennis Anliker, and her sister-in-law, Cynthia Henderson.

Iris is survived by her daughter, Analisa Bohr of Austin; her grandson, Derek Fuller & his wife, Stephanie of Los Angeles, CA; two great grandsons, Theo and Drake Fuller of Los Angeles, CA; one step great grandson, Danny Thomas of Los Angeles, CA; one brother, Donald Henderson of St. Charles, MO; two sisters, Ruth Boethel & her husband Carey of Austin and Hazel Anliker of Reno, NV; one sister-in-law, Regina Henderson of Austin, as well as many nieces and nephews.
