Jack Thornton Kirk, 68, of Snook, Texas went to be with our Lord and Savior on Saturday, October 1, 2022. Visitation with the family will be held on Saturday, October 8th from 9 :00 to 11:00 AM at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Caldwell, followed by a memorial service at 11:00 AM.

Jack was born on June 17, 1954 to Tommy and Beatrice (Walker) Kirk in Cameron, Texas. He was one of four siblings. Jack graduated from CH Yoe High School in Cameron, Texas in 1972 and continued to follow Yoe sports. Jack was a member of the Snook Brethren Church and attended Marlow Baptist Church to hear his brother's Sunday message.

Jack married Cynthia Kovar on April 10, 1987 and they made their home in Snook. Jack was a carpenter by trade and traveled the United States with his construction projects. He ended his career at CHI St. Joseph, retiring in May 2019. Jack took pride in his garden and built above ground garden boxes before they became popular. He was a faithful University of Texas Longhorns fan and proud owner of his Harley Davidson "Fat Boy" motorcycle. He was a loving and supportive father (Daddy) and an adoring grandfather (Papa). 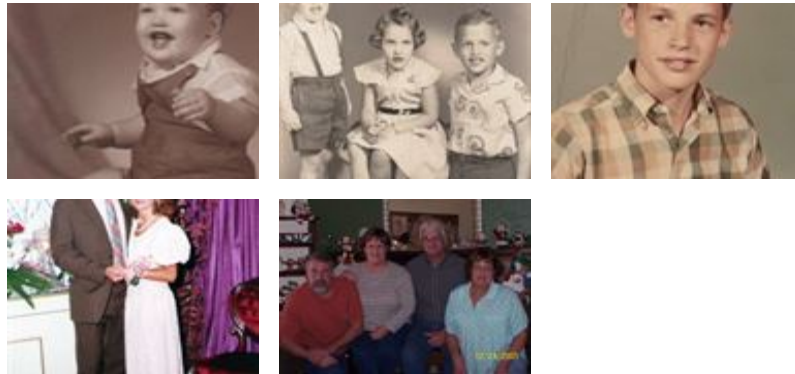
