James Spenser Duncan was born on September 6, 1989 in Beaumont, Texas to Jeffery Brent & Teresa Ann (Hill) Duncan. He graduated from Giddings High School in 2008. Spenser was employed by the Veteran's Administration as a nurse's aide. He enjoyed teaching various sports to junior high and high school students, working with his family and disabled veterans, loved teaching and playing with his daughter, and helping out at the family farm in Giddings.

James passed away unexpectedly the evening of Monday, October 2, 2017 at the family farm in Giddings.
