Obituary for James Theodore Hubert, Jr.

James Theodore Hubert, Jr. (Ted), former Superintendent of Milano Independent School District (1984-1994) died in his home on August 1, 2024. Ted was born in Miami, Florida on December 21, 1931, to James T. Hubert Sr. and Virginia Hubert and was the oldest of three children. He lived in Florida until graduation from high school.

During the Korean War, he served his country through the military branch of the U.S. Coast Guard. Following his military duty, Ted began his collegiate career at Atlantic Christian College (ACC), now Barton College, in Wilson, North Carolina, receiving a Bachelor of Arts degree in 1959. While attending ACC, Ted met Thurla Boswell whom he married on October 16, 1958, in Anchorage, AK. Ted and Thurla had two children, Jay and Ben.

Ted began his life-long career as an educator in Norfolk, Va. as an elementary school teacher. While teaching in Virginia, Ted received his Master of Education degree from The College of William and Mary in 1967. In 1972, the Hubert's moved to Texas where Ted began teaching at Lohn ISD. While teaching and coaching at Lohn, he received his Texas Teaching Certification for grades 1-12 and his Mid-management Administrator certificate from Angelo State University. In 1974, he became the high school principal at San

Saba ISD, serving for 10 years. While in San Saba, he received his Texas Professional Superintendent Certificate in 1984 from Texas State University and became Superintendent for Milano ISD. Upon retirement, Ted and Thurla retired in Milano and continued serving this community and beyond.

Ted was involved and held offices in Triad, Texas Silver-Haired Legislature, Retired Teachers Association, Democratic Election Judge, American Legion, former member of First Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) in Cameron, and Milano Volunteer Fire Department. In addition, upon retirement, he was a weekly contributor columnist to the Rockdale Reporter for many years.

Ted was also involved and in love with his family who hold a lifetime of memories, especially of family vacations on the Texas coast. He will also be remembered for his passion for sports, enjoying the beauty of nature at his home, and his cows. He is survived by his wife of 66 years, Thurla and their two sons, Jay Hubert of Milano, Texas and Ben Hubert and Tamara Strehli of San Angelo, Texas and two former daughters-in-law, Carlie McClain of Little Rock AR, and Leann Forbes of San Angelo, Texas. He was Paw-Paw to four grandchildren and two great grandchildren: Ryan and Heather Hubert of Bryan, Texas, Carri Ann Jordan of Bella Vista AK, James T. Hubert III. and Lurn Winn of Rogers AK., and Evan Hubert and Christina Marino of Dallas, Texas. His great grandchildren are Braxton Hubert and Raylan Hubert of Rogers AR. He was preceded in death by his parents, two siblings, Frank Hubert and Marcia Penn of Florida and numerous uncles, aunts, and cousins who played a significant role in his formative years.

A memorial service will be held for Ted on August 6, 2024, 11:00 a.m., at the Milano Volunteer Fire Department, the Revs. Ben G. Hubert and Tamara Strehli officiating.

The family wishes to thank Fire Chief Cain Dodd for overseeing the arrangement for the service. The family also requests memorials to be made

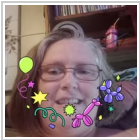
