James "Smutt" Smith was born May 26, 1923 in Lee County to Ed and Idella (Sarrett) Smith. He was a lifelong resident of Lee County and attended Lexington I.S.D. He joined the Navy and served during World War II. He married Evelyn Loraine Smith on December 25, 1952 and they had two children. He retired from metal service with Alcoa in 1976 after 22 years. He continued to haul cattle after his retirement. He was an active fisherman, enjoyed building cattle feeders and he and Jimmy went to town every day to collect the latest news. He loved being with his family. He was a member of the Lexington American Legion Post 6.

James passed away Tuesday, December 29, 2015 in the Scott & White Hospital in Taylor at the age of 92. He was preceded in death by his parents, three brothers and two sisters.

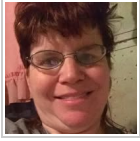

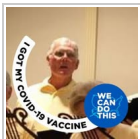
