Graveside services for Janice Davis, 86 of Austin, will be held at a later date at Burns Cemetery in Blue, Texas.

Janice passed the morning of Thursday, November 3, 2022 in Austin, Texas.

Janice Marie Steele was born January 22, 1936 and raised in the Panama Canal Zone in an Army doctor's family. After WWII, the family returned to the US by ship, and Janice was disappointed she missed the Statue of Liberty since they disembarked in New Orleans. Settling in Greenwood, Indiana she met the love of her life, Jim Davis. At 18 years old, she was diagnosed with Juvenile Diabetes (Type 1), which she successfully managed throughout her life. Janice and Jim graduated from Indiana University in Bloomington and were wed on August 24, 1957. Janice helped raise 2 children while moving around the US as an Air Force family. She was active in church, singing in the choir and playing piano. In addition, Janice was a leader in Recovery International, helping people to improve their mental health, and change their lives for the better. After her children graduated high school, she worked as a receptionist at the Austin Diagnostic Clinic. After retirement, she traveled the US in an RV with her husband Jim. In 2007, they celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary with family and friends in Greenwood, Indiana where it all began. Janice was awarded the 50-year Joslin Diabetes Center medal for taking such good care of herself. In her later years, she inspired many newly-

diagnosed Type 1 diabetics, giving them hope for their future. Known for her smile, Janice was always interested in people, their origins, and interests. She went home to be with the Lord on November 3, 2022.

Janice Davis is preceded in death by her parents Dorothy and Russell Steele as well as her husband Jim Davis. She is survived by her older brother Jim Steele in Florida, younger sister Ann Geerken in California, and younger brother Chuck Steele in Michigan.

Janice is also survived by two children and their spouses: Brad Davis and Jeanne Davis in San Marcos as well as Joyce Davis and Mike Hagye in Bee Cave. Finally, she is survived by her grandchildren: Carlianne Hagye in San Antonio, Van Hagye and his wife Livi in Austin, Chelsea Davis in San Marcos, and Happy Davis in Renton, Washington.
