Jeanette (Friedrich) Coker, 88, of Caldwell, passed away peacefully on November 7, 2025.

Jeanette was born in Holland, Texas, to Mabel and Herbert Friedrich on January 17, 1937. She married the love of her life, Leland Coker, on November 3, 1956 and together they made their home in Caldwell beginning in January 1957.

Jeanette devoted many years to being a loving homemaker. She was active in her children's lives — helping with their 4-H projects, serving as a Cub Scout leader and cheering on her boys at the little league baseball games with her daughter by her side keeping score. When her children were older she went to work at Leisure Lodge Nursing Home for many years. She then left her job to become a caregiver for her parents at their farm in Holland , Texas.

favorite places to spend time. She and Leland loved to go dancing together and could often be found at local dances enjoying good music and good company. One of her greatest joys was cheering on her granddaughters as they played volleyball for the Holland Hornets and the Caldwell Hornets.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Leland Coker; her parents, Mabel and Herbert Friedrich; and two brothers Raymond Friedrich and James Friedrich.
