



## Jeff Dock

December 6, 1951 - September 27, 2015

Jeff Dock was a compassionate and hardworking man who loved his family more than words can say. Jeff passed away on September 27, 2015 in his 64th year of life napping on his back porch after an enjoyable day of church and yard work.

Jeff is survived by a large and loving family including his mother, Maryalice Dock of Lewisburg, PA; his wife, L'Anna Dock of Giddings; four children, Alisha Nicks & her husband, Bobby of San Antonio, Alan Dock & his wife, Amanda of Bryan, Adam Dock who is attending Sam Houston State University in Huntsville and Alaina Dock who is attending Lamar University in Beaumont; his two grandchildren who were his cutie pies, Audrey and Robert Nicks of San Antonio; two brothers, Gregory Dock of Deltona, FL and Kevin Dock & his wife, Debbie of Lewisburg, PA; his sister, Pam Sobol & her husband, Jeff of Lewisburg, PA; niece, Samantha Herbster & her husband, Nick of Harrisburg, PA and two nephews, Thomas Denius of Austin and Eric Dock of Bloomsburg, PA. Jeff also leaves behind his best friends, Millard Locke, Ron Foster and Ronnie Joe Niensteadt.

He was preceded in death by his father, Charlie Dock.

Charles Jeffrey Dock was born on December 6, 1951 in Lewisburg, Pennsylvania, the son of Charles Frederick Dock and Maryalice Reimert

Dock. He graduated from Lewisburg High School and received his bachelor degree from Lockhaven University and his Master of Education Administration from Southwest Texas State University. He was united in marriage to L'Anna Howard on July 27, 1984 in San Antonio, Texas. Jeff had been employed by the Giddings Independent School District for 23 years having served as the Giddings Middle School Assistant Principal from 1992-1995, the Giddings Elementary School Principal from 1995-1997, the Giddings Intermediate School Principal from 1997-2007 and since 2007 has served as Giddings ISD Director of Support Services, Interim Superintendent and was currently the school district's business manager. He served on the board of the Centex Family Services and was a member of the Giddings Breakfast Lions Club. Jeff was seen every Sunday at Martin Luther Lutheran Church in Giddings where he was an active member and had been past president, and currently the president-elect of the church council, served on the nominating and call committees, was an assisting minister and communion assistant and also led the adult bible study.

Not only was he a very busy man at work, but he never missed any of his children's sporting events. He always looked for time to cut down trees and have a fire. At the end of the day you could find him sitting on the porch with a Bud Light bottle in his hand and a smile on his face. His wife and children will miss the campfires and the 60's dance parties in the backyard. Every time we hear a cow mooing or smell a fire burning our hearts will be full of the memories and happiness of our wonderful and amazing husband, daddy and friend.
