Jenny Kay Kubiak was born March 19, 1947, in Temple, Texas to Sam Simmons Perry of Lexington and Melba Mignon (Rutherford) Perry of Giddings.

Jenny grew up in Rockdale and attended and graduated from Rockdale High School in 1965. While in High School she served on student counsel.
