



Jerald "Jerry" Carroll Hielscher

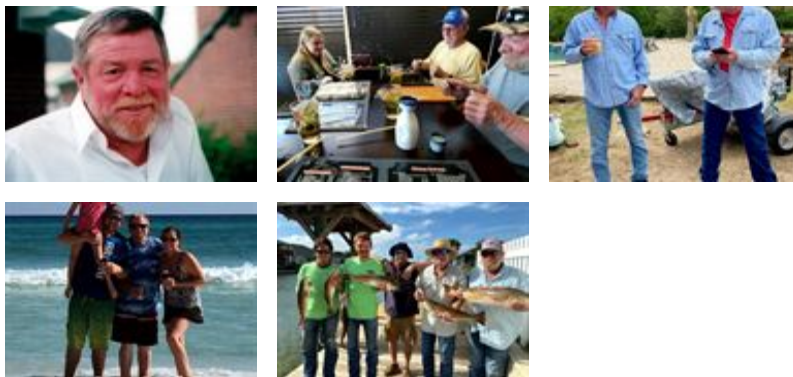
