Jerry Lynn Biar was born November 26th, 1948 to Gerhard and Frances Biar. He passed away on Sunday, September 18, 2024. He would grow up on a farm just outside of Thorndale with his parents and four siblings. Jerry would make Thorndale his home, raising a family that he loved very much.
