October 5, 1948 - August 27, 2021

Jerry Earl England, 72, of Sugar Land, Texas was met at The Golden Gates of Heaven by His Lord, family, friends, and pets on the morning of August 27, 2021.

Jerry was born on October 5, 1948 in Cincinnati, Ohio to Lester and Mildred (Caine) England. He moved to Dallas/Fort Worth, Texas in the late 70's to avoid the harsh winters and fell in love with Texas. He would boast to his late brother Ron about being able to play golf all year round; in shorts.

In a private ceremony, Jerry married Elinor (Cilny) Seesing on December 14, 1996 in San Antonio on Marriage Island on the Riverwalk. They were accompanied by Brandon, her son playing the violin and sister Kathy. This was the beginning of an amazing journey together. Jerry loved life and it showed with all his hobbies and adventures. As a young man in Ohio, he raced rally cars, loved camping, dancing and playing golf. When he moved to Texas, his interest expanded to duck hunting, and his love for his duck dog Sparky, who he raised from a tiny pup. Sailing all over the Caribbean with his new friends gave him a lifetime of joy. Jerry was a physical hands-on guy, hiking, restoring on his El Camino and an antique 8N tractor. Later in life, he enjoyed buying mowing tractors and riding his motorcycle with his friend Howard. Jerry recently became involved with cowboy action shooting and was pretty good at it. He became a cowboy.

Professionally, Jerry was a CPA creating England & Company in Houston, Texas.

Jerry always said he couldn't retire because he and Ellen loved to travel, and they would need money to see the world, and that they did! They traveled all over Europe, RVing the U.S. and shared many honey moon vacation trips.

Besides travel, Jerry was heavily involved with charity and support groups: Council on Recovery; Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo; Mankind Project/Men in Mission; Friends of Bill W. of 32 years, and his greatest joy, Santa Claus. He loved being Santa and seeing the faces of young and old, so much so, he took acting classes to become a better Santa. Jerry excelled in acting too. He was in the movie "Playing God" for theaters and the television movie "It's A New Lease on Christmas". So yes, he was a TV and Movie Star!

Jerry's other great love was being involved in "Land of My Grandfathers" and "Man Kind Project". He was a Ritual Elder and mentor to many men that he respected and loved. At the camp, he enjoyed mowing the property and meditating in the country air with solitude as well as listening to the coyotes in the night.

Jerry leaves to carry on his love of life to his best friend and wife Ellen England, son Brandon and wife Lauren Seesing of Cypress, Texas, his latest pup, Jack; step-mother, Charlotte England of Hamilton Ohio; half-brother Jay Walton and wife Carol of Cleveland Ohio; countless extended Cilny family members and numerous friends and colleagues.

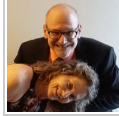

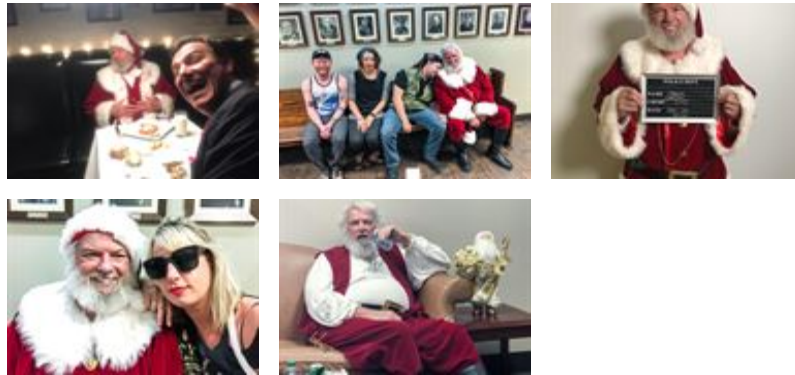

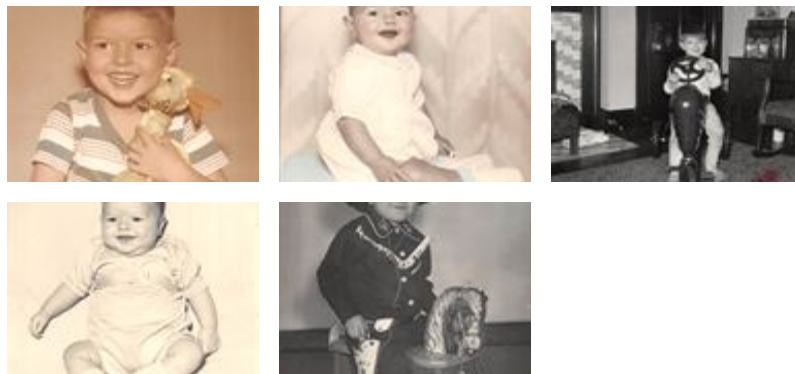
