Jerry Wayne Pulley, age 61, of Rockdale, passed away peacefully on Saturday, December 6, 2025, after a courageous four-year battle with cancer. Funeral services will be held on Friday, December 12, 2025, at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home, located at 1041 US 79, Rockdale, TX 76567. Visitation will take place from 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m., followed immediately by a Memorial Service.
