Jerry Glen Smith was born on June 26, 1948 in Houston, Texas to Hubert and Myrtle (Martin) Smith. He served in the Army during the Vietnam War. 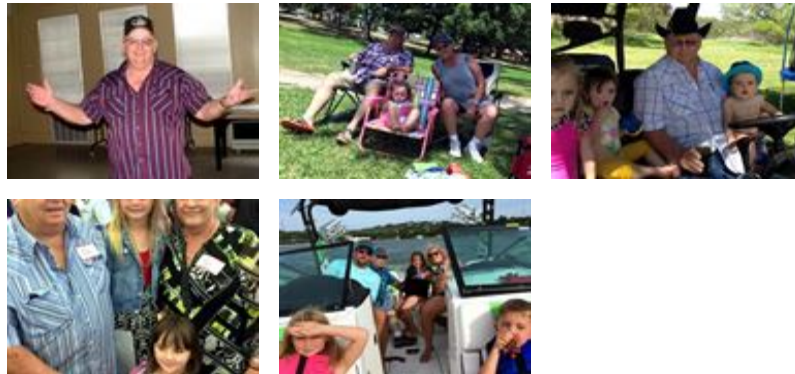
