Jesse William Weise, age 93, of Dallas, Texas went to be with the Lord on January 12, 2009. He was a loving husband to Glenna (Stout) and a wonderful father to two daughters. Jesse was born September 23, 1915 in Giddings, TX. He attended Texas Lutheran College in Seguin, TX and later graduated from The University of Texas in Austin, TX, receiving a B.S. degree in Civil Engineering. Before even receiving his final grades he was inducted into the U.S. Army Air Corps in May, 1943. He served our country in World War II in the European Theater especially in England and Germany. He was also a part of the Occupational Forces in Germany at the end of the war. He began his engineering career with Humble Oil & Refining Company. After working in south Texas, Alabama and Louisiana, Mr. Weise retired from a lengthy career with Exxon in 1984. He and his wife retired to Victoria, TX where he enjoyed golf, fishing, gardening and playing dominoes. He was an active member of The Lutheran Church Missouri Synod his entire life. He was preceded in death by his parents, Carl and Mary (Symm) Weise; his four brothers, Gilbert, Irvin, Clarence and Freddie; and his sister, Margaret Pierce.
