Jewel Vivian Rosas, 93, of Caldwell passed away Saturday, May 6, 2017 at Burlison St. Joseph Manor in Caldwell. Graveside services will be held at 2 pm Tuesday, May 9 at Caldwell Masonic Cemetery with Rev. Delmar McCracken officiating. Visitation will be Tuesday at the cemetery from 1 pm until service time.

Mrs. Rosas was born July 13, 1923 in the Harmony Community of Burlison County to Harry Barnett Green and Mamie Mae (Sell) Green. She attended Harmony School and Caldwell High School. She married Seth Ryan in 1940. Seth later died of an aneurysm. In 1951, she married Martin Rosas and they remained married until his death in 1990. In her early years, she worked at The Bargain Barn and Simpson's Grocery in Caldwell. After moving to Bryan in the mid '50s she worked as a babysitter for several families through the years. She also worked for the City of Bryan as park attendant and as a school crossing guard. For many years she was a volunteer worker at local nursing homes.

She enjoyed gardening, fishing, visiting friends and entertaining the neighborhood kids. Spending time with her family, her dog "prissy" and her friends at Martin's Place were among her favorite things.

Jewel was preceded in death by her parents and her husbands, Seth Ryan

and Martin Rosas.
