Jo Anna Gerzik Dubcak Dorr of Caldwell went home to be with the Lord on February 2, 2012 at Copperas Hollow Nursing and Rehabilitation Center at the age of 59 years after a two year battle of cancer. Jo Anna was born May 28, 1952 to Margaret and Joseph Lee Gerzik of Snook, Texas. Jo Anna was always full of spunk, laughter and a mischievous prankster. Making people laugh and Alan Jackson's music brought her the lots joy. Jo Anna began her career in law enforcement at Texas A&M University - University Police as a dispatcher. She later completed her law enforcement training as a Patrol Officer and later a detective. She was voted officer of the year while at University Police. Later she relocated to Caldwell, Texas as a detective and there she also received the award as "Office of the Year". She later moved to Jennings Louisiana where she continued her career as a detective for five years. While in Jennings she received an Outstanding Appreciation Award. When her health declined she moved back to Caldwell, Texas to be with her family. In February 2010 Jo Anna was diagnosed with Lung Cancer, she chose palliative care instead of seeking treatment, because she wanted quality life for her last days. Jo Anna loved her son, Michael and daughter, Michelle especially her grandsons, Devin, Dylan and Jordan. Jo Anna was the "True American Woman" she supported the US Military Troops, even to the point of decorating two of her rooms in Red, White and Blue.
