Jo "Fran" Hasty, 56, of Austin, Texas, died on Tuesday, March 13, 2018 at St. David's Medical Center in Austin.

Jo Frances (Bazor) Hasty was born in Laurel, Mississippi on October 9, 1961 to James Caraway Bazor Jr. and Frances Yvonne (Malone) Bazor. After high school, she obtained a degree in computer programming from Spencer College in Baton Rouge, Louisiana. Fran is survived by her sister, Lori Bazor of Giddings; her daughter, Amanda Waguespack & her husband, Gene of Louisiana; two sons, Justin Hasty & his wife, Tabitha of Oklahoma and Joshua Hasty & his wife, Robin of Louisiana; her eight grandchildren who she loved dearly; one nephew, Michael McCoy &
