Jo Ann (McNeese) Watson was born on January 10, 1936 in Logan, Texas, the first daughter of H.O. McNeese and Louie Reeves McNeese. She passed away peacefully, surrounded by her family, in Bryan, Texas on Sunday, June 16, 2024 at the age of 88.

Jo Ann was a graduate of Pasadena High School and upon graduation began work at Prudential Insurance in Houston, Texas. She married the love of her life, Billy Carl Watson, on June 15, 1958 and they spent over 55 years together and raised three daughters in the Northshore area of Houston. Jo Ann was a stay at home mother when her girls were young, and went back to work when her youngest daughter went to kindergarten. She then began her career at the Harris County Sheriff's Office in the purchasing department, and retired after many years of service. Upon retirement, the Watsons moved to their lake house in Plum Ridge, Zavalla, Texas where they enjoyed fishing, boating, playing games and visiting with their friends, neighbors, and family.

Jo Ann was an active member of Woodforest Baptist Church in Houston for many years, raising her daughters to know and love Jesus Christ. Later on, she attended Salem Missionary Baptist Church in Huntington, Texas and Caldwell Church of Christ in Caldwell, Texas. She had a generous servant's heart and modeled those values for her children and grandchildren. She was an avid quilter, and enjoyed crafting, gardening, and shopping, but her most

beloved role was mother and grandmother. In 2015, Jo Ann married her friend Charles and they enjoyed six years of travel and companionship together.

Jo Ann is preceded in death by her husband and parents; her brothers, Wayne and Bill McNeese; sister, Vencie Hill; sister-in-law, Shirley McNeese; brother-in-law, Don Hill; son-in-law, Nick Griffin; and second husband, Charles Magee.

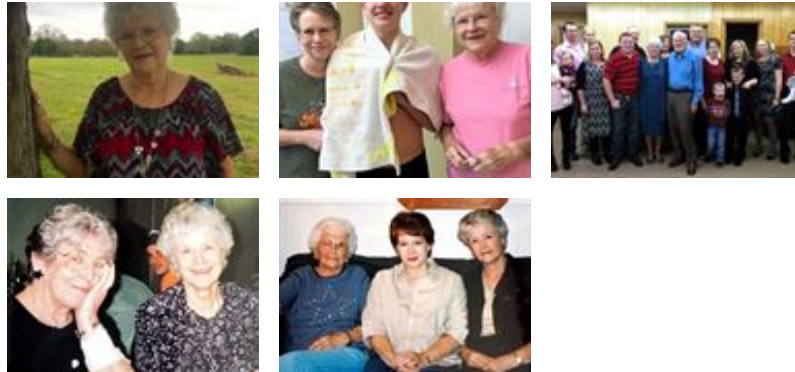

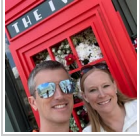
