JoAnn loved the Lord and always strived to live her life in a way that was pleasing to Him. She was an active member of the First United Methodist Church in Caldwell, where over the years she served on various committees and sang in the church choir. JoAnn was very proud of her Czech heritage, She was a member of the Czech museum in Caldwell where she enjoyed giving tours and singing with the Burleson County Czech Singers at the Kolache Festival. She also volunteered at the Caldwell Christian Care Center and was a member of the VFW Post 4458 Ladies Auxiliary.

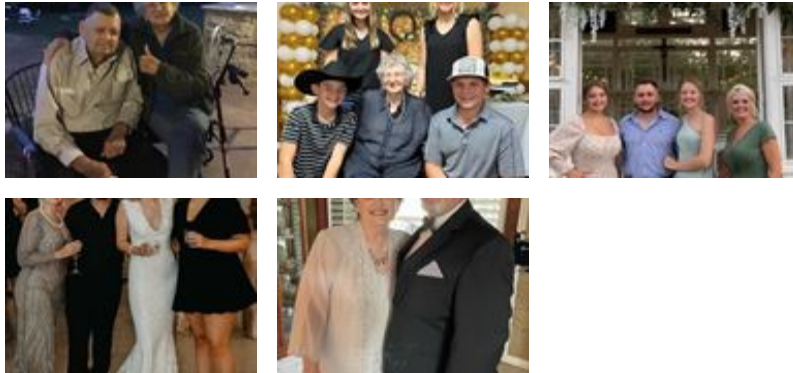
