Joe Brown was born March 1, 1919 in Rockdale to Joseph and Tonie (Seelke) Brown. He attended school in Bethlehem and Rockdale. By the age of 10, he was driving a Model "T" into town by himself, and at the age of 14 he started working in the oil fields for W.A. Jones. He was operating a well service pulling machine in the Minerva and Rockdale oil fields full time at the age of 15. On May 18, 1938 he and the love of his life, Alice Lee Drummond were married in the Sharp Presbyterian Church. He worked four years as leader in the burning department in the Houston Ship Channel. He had a welding shop and grocery store in the Tracy Community. He spent years as a Boilermaker and finally joined the faculty at Texas A&M University, which he retired from in 1994 with the status of Drilling Instructor and Research Associate in the Petroleum Engineers. He was once asked, is there anything you cannot do? And he answered "Yeah can't walk on water."

He was a member of Tracy Methodist Church in the Tracy Community. In his younger years, he loved hunting, fishing and the outdoors. An avid collector of cap and ball guns, Model "A" Fords and Indian Artifacts. Everything in his life

came second to his family.

Joe passed away Thursday afternoon, February 4, 2016 at his home. He was preceded in death by his wife of 73 years, Alice on February 21, 2011; Grandson, Robert Anderson in 2003; his parents and half-brother, Alton Hunt.
