Joe Dan “JD” Morrison, 72, of Rockdale passed away on Wednesday, August 12, 2020 at Scott & White in Temple. He was born on December 17, 1947 to A.D. and Olevia Mack Morrison in Caldwell. He graduated, class of 1966, from Blackshear High School in Odessa. After high school, Joe served in the United States Army for two years, including a tour in Vietnam.
