



John "Johnny" Wayne Stamport

July 2, 1947 - April 25, 2018

Funeral services for John "Johnny" Wayne Stamport, 70, of Loebau, Texas are scheduled for 10:00 A.M. on Saturday, April 28, 2018 at Christ Lutheran Church in Loebau with Rev. Garrett Smith officiating. Burial, with military honors provided by the Giddings American Legion York Post 276, will follow in the church cemetery. Visitation will be held on Friday, April 27, 2018 from 7:00 A.M. until 8:00 P.M. and on Saturday, April 28, 2018 from 7:00 A.M. until 8:00 A.M. at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. John "Johnny" Stamport was born on July 2, 1947 to Wheeler & Gladys (Hamilton) Stamport at his home in Lexington, Texas. He was baptized on December 22, 1969 and confirmed on December 28, 1969 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Houston by Pastor Elmo E. Miertschin. Johnny was drafted in 1968 into the Army and served a year in Vietnam. Upon his return, he was united in marriage to Nellie Jean Beisert on June 13, 1969 at Christ Lutheran Church in Loebau by Rev. Andrew Szegedin. After getting married, he was a sheetrocker in Houston and later he came back to Lee County and worked for Lee County Petroleum. Johnny then went to work for Lee County in the maintenance department and retired in 2012.

Johnny is remembered for being a huge fan of the Dallas Cowboys. He loved butchering with the family every year and fixing up "stuff". He also loved the

annual Halloween hayrides and the New Year's Eve celebrations.

Johnny passed away the morning of Wednesday, April 25, 2018 at the Hospice Brazos Valley Inpatient Facility in Bryan following a battle with cancer.
