John "Doug" Johnson, 66, of Conroe, formerly of Gause, passed away Thursday, September 11, 2014 at his residence. Church services are set for 11:00am, Monday, September 15, 2014 at First Baptist Church in Gause with Pastor Jimmy Sanders officiating and burial to follow at the Gause City Cemetery. Visitation will be from 4:00pm to 6:00pm on Sunday, September 14, 2014 at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Rockdale.

Doug was born November 3, 1947 in Houston to John D. and Henrietta Polly (Fuller) Johnson. He attended Gause Elementary School and Hearne High School. Doug proudly served in the U.S. Army from November 1972 to June 1975. He married Shirley Aline Stuckey on January 20, 1981 in Anahuac, Texas. He was a heavy equipment operator, automotive technician and preacher of the gospel. Doug gave his life to the Lord as a young boy at the Baptist Church in Gause, Texas. Totally and truly gave his whole heart and soul in 1980 at Christian Tabernacle in Houston, Texas and was filled with the Holy Ghost and Baptized in his Name, loving the Lord with his whole heart and soul and told everyone he talked to from the time he was filled with the Holy Ghost. He never changed and never wavered in his beliefs. He never stopped talking about God, and would do so to anyone and everyone he met. Doug loved his family with all his heart and soul and would have given his own life for anyone of them, even if they didn't listen to him! In the beginning of his battle with cancer, the Lord told him he would be ok. The doctor's however

wanted to tell him how long he had to live, but he said no one knew but the Lord. They wanted to tell him he had less than 6 months to live, but that was March of 2012 so he and the Lord fooled mankind once again. He fought this terrible disease for over two years for it's not over until the Lord says so and even then, it's just the beginning for anyone who has known for years or just ten minutes. Know he will be walking hand in hand with Jesus.

He is preceded in death by his parents; and sisters, Penny Johnson and JoAnn Johnson McCormick.

Doug is survived by his wife of 33 years, Shirley Stuckey Johnson of Conroe; sons, Shane Johnson and wife Sonya of Conroe, and Keith Johnson and wife Crystal of LaPorte; daughters, Shelly Beamesderfer and husband Brent of Dayton, Kimberley Dawn Hereford of Conroe, and Joyce Ann Hereford of Conroe; brother, James Darwin "Tootie" Johnson and wife Delores of Rockdale; 16 grandchildren and 7 great grandchildren.

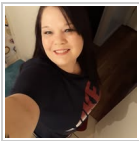
