



John Desmond Romoser

June 19, 1920 - April 8, 2008

Services for John Desmond Romoser, 87, of Keota, Iowa, and Rockdale were held Saturday, April 12, 2008, at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Rockdale with Minister O.E. Davidson of Milam County Church of Christ officiating. Burial was in I.O.O.F. Cemetery in Rockdale. Mr. Romoser died Tuesday, April 8, in Scott & White Hospital in Temple. He was born June 19, 1920, in Keota, Iowa, to Theodore and Elma (Pulver) Romoser. He married Evelyn Pruett on Dec. 28, 1950, in Rockdale. Mr. Romoser was a World War II veteran, serving in the 79th Division. He was a Purple Heart recipient for wounds received after driving over a land mine during the invasion of Normandy. He served from 1942 until 1946 with time spent in military hospitals in England and the U.S. Mr. Romoser was a farmer, member of the Church of Christ and a lifetime member of D.A.V. He was preceded in death by his parents and a brother. Survivors are his wife, Evelyn Romoser of Keota, Iowa, and Rockdale; and three nephews, John R. Romoser of Florida, Robert Romoser and Gary Romoser, both of Keota, Iowa. Pallbearers were Randy Holt, John Pruett Jr., Kenny Shipp, Barrett Brannam, Charles Edelman and Austin Edelman.
