Johnny Randall Dismukes also known as "Booter" was born on November 22, 1952, in Houston, Texas to Johnny Clifton Dismukes and Alta Lea (Simmons) Dismukes. He attended school in Lexington and graduated from Lexington High School in 1971. Randy married Rita Mundine on June 21, 2002, in Fredericksburg, Texas. He worked as a printer with the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) for over 20 years. After retiring from TxDOT, Randy was a school bus driver for Lexington ISD for 17 years. He was a member of the Lexington Volunteer Fire Department from 1971 until 1992 and served as fire chief from 1986 until 1992. Randy enjoyed listening to music, sang and played drums in two of his teenage bands, watching Longhorn football, occasional gambling trips to Louisiana, he took great pride in his small mowing business and detailing his vehicles. He loved taking care of his dogs and spending time with his family, especially his grandson, Maxton. He will be remembered for his love for his family, his devotion to his community, and his infectious laugh and smile.

Randy passed away unexpectedly the morning of Tuesday, February 18, 2025, at his home in Lexington.

He was preceded in death by his parents and brother-in-law, Tony Reda.

Randy is survived by his wife, Rita Mundine of Lexington; daughter and son-in-law, Marla & Brent Granger of Pflugerville; grandson, Maxton Granger of Pflugerville; two stepsons, Clint Frerich & wife, Michelle of Austin and Casey Frerich of Crowley; sister, Kay Reda of Austin; niece, Jessica Reda of Lexington and great niece, Kristyn Ruthven of Lexington.
