Jon Allen Morgan, 50 from Caldwell Texas went to be with his Lord and Savior on July 30, 2018 after a short battle with cancer. A Celebration of his life will be held on Saturday, August 11, 2018 at Life Church in Bryan, Texas at 11 am. Jon was born in Lebanon Indiana May 6, 1968 to Roberta McKinsey Morgan-Owens and James (Jim) Morgan. Jon graduated from Western Boone High School in 1986 and went into the Army National Guard. While in the military Jon received numerous commendations for his dedication. When asked why he chose artillery he replied “I thought it would be cool to blow things up”. He served his country for 14 years.

Jon met his soul mate, Charlotte Marie Kuzminski while he was chasing his passion in the racing industry. They married on April 19, 2003 where they combined their children to become a blended family. His granddaughters thought the world of him, and his grandsons wanted to be like him. Friends were always telling us what an amazing man he was.
