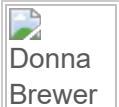

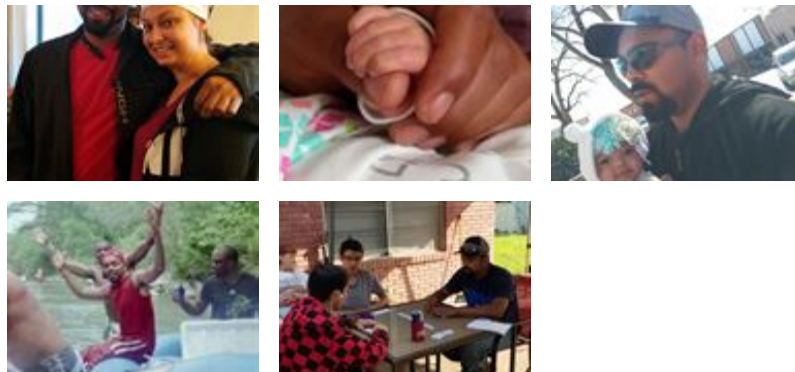
She and Mildred along with those handsome Batiste brothers of Shiloh, wow we had the best time out in the country!
