Joyce Beasley, a devoted child of Father God, peacefully passed away at her home on Saturday, October 28, 2023 surrounded by her loving family.

Visitation will be held on Friday, November 3, 2023, from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm. at Phillips & Luckey Funeral home in Lexington. The funeral service will take place on Saturday, November 4, 2023 at 2:00 pm at Adina Christian Church. Burial will follow at Adina Cemetery.

Born on May 30, 1933, in Thorndale to Howard and Medie Cuzzort, Joyce spent her early years in Lexington, where she started her education and met the love of her life, Clayton Beasley. The family later relocated to Robinson, and Joyce and Clayton's bond grew stronger. They exchanged vows on February 14, 1951, and settled on the family ranch in Lexington.

Joyce and Clayton owned and operated the Sunrise Café in Lexington before Joyce joined her mother-in-law, Lillie Beasley, at the café at the Auction Barn. Together, Joyce and Clayton were blessed with two children, Janice and Richard. In 1968, Joyce began working in the cafeteria at Lexington public school, where students affectionately called her Mama, Granny, and Mrs. B as they passed through the lunch line. She retired from Lexington in 2000, but

her lunch rolls are still remembered and cherished today.

In 1976, Joyce became a part of the summer work staff at Tanglewood Christian Camp, where she managed the cafeteria for many years. The campers lovingly bestowed upon her the name Aunt B, a name that stayed with her throughout her life.

Joyce and Clayton were devoted members of Adina Christian Church, known for their hospitality and generosity towards missionaries, visiting preachers, and Bible College students. Joyce actively served in various roles within the church, including teaching Sunday School and Junior Church, as well as being the dedicated Vacation Bible School (VBS) Director for many years. She served as Secretary, Treasure and other areas of the Adina Cemetery Association. She exemplified the qualities of a Proverbs 31 wife to Clayton and their family, adorning herself with strength and honor.

In 2001, Joyce and Clayton joyfully celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary, cherishing their marital bond until Clayton's passing in 2013.

Joyce is preceded in death by her parents, husband Clayton, and sister Faye Bairrington. She is survived by her daughter and son-in-law, Janice and David Suter of Cleveland, OK, her son Richard Beasley of Lexington; Janice's children Justin and Shannon Meshek, Gracie Meshek; Richard's children Patrick and Cheryl Beasley, Shane and Bri Beasley, Jonathan Matthew Rasco, Michael Wayne Rasco, and Stephen Rasco, and their mother, Maggie Beasley. 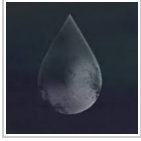

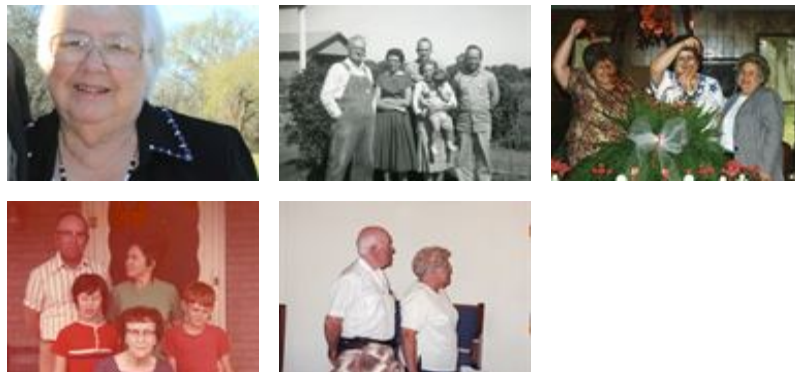

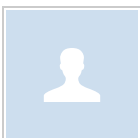
