



## Joyce L. Zwerneman

January 20, 1929 - August 26, 2014

Joyce Wiederhold Zwerneman, 85, of Dime Box, Texas passed away on August 26, 2014, surrounded by her family, with her husband of 65 years, Fred, by her side.

Joyce was born in Deanville, Texas, on January 20, 1929. She was baptized at the Lutheran Church in Deanville, confirmed at St. John's Lutheran Church in Dime Box, and graduated from Dime Box School. On August 28, 1949, Joyce married Fred Zwerneman at Martin Luther Lutheran Church in Giddings, Texas, and the two made their home in Austin and Pflugerville. Joyce worked for Southwestern Bell for more than 40 years, serving as one of the first women to work on the frame. She taught Sunday School at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Pflugerville for many years, where she was an active member until she and Fred moved "home" to Dime Box in 2001. Joyce enjoyed family reunions, quilting, playing dominos and cards with family and friends, and trips to Coushatta. But most important to Joyce was her family, and she is remembered as a devoted wife, mother, grandmother, and great-grandmother. When her kids married and started families of their own, she began inviting the whole family over for Sunday dinner once a month, a tradition that became known as "Second Sunday" and continues for more than 40 years later.

Joyce is survived by her husband of 65 years, Fred, of Dime Box; son Freddie

and daughter-in-law Bobbie of Georgetown; grandchildren Stacey Zwerneman of Georgetown, Derick and April Zwerneman of Round Rock, Robert Frazier of Pflugerville, Regan and Rachele Frazier of Tomball, Sarah and Chris Boyle of Pflugerville, and Cheryl Frazier of Pflugerville; great-grandchildren Sidney Boyle, Jaxon Zwerneman, London Zwerneman, Grace Frazier, Wesley Boyle, Kayla Frazier, Liberty Zwerneman, and Jessa Frazier; brothers Wilburn Wiederhold of Giddings, Edgar Wiederhold of Giddings, Robert and Alice Wiederhold of Caldwell, and J.C. and Dorothy Wiederhold of Dime Box; and sisters Alene Cottrell of Dime Box, and Lavern and Leroy Zwerneman of Georgetown; and numerous nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends.
