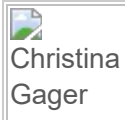
Judith was preceded in death by her parents; her husband; her brother, Bobby Parker and her daughter-in-law, Gina Carroll.

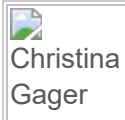
