Memorial services for Judith "Judy" Ann Winters, 76, of Giddings, Texas, are scheduled for 11:00 a.m. on Monday, March 14, 2016 at the First Presbyterian Church in Giddings with Rev. Chris Harrison officiating.

Judith Ann "Judy" Winters was born on February 7, 1940 in Detroit, Michigan, the daughter of William and Marjorie (Dorman) Warbis. Judy received both her undergraduate and her Master's Degree from Michigan State University. She went on to teach at Percy Julian School. Judy was united in marriage to Richard Cole in Detroit, MI. They were blessed with two children, Mitchell and Sally. After the loss of Richard, she was blessed to find George Douglas Winters. Judy and Doug were united in marriage on March 18, 1989 in New Orleans, LA. 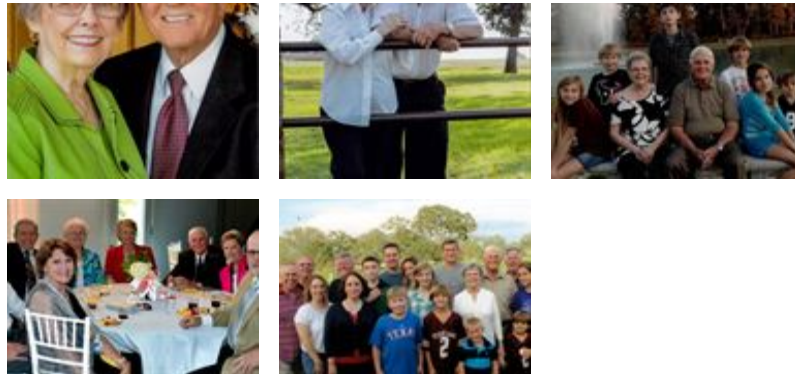
