



Kenneth Lee Ahlschlaeger

June 8, 1933 - December 12, 2019

Funeral services for Kenneth Ahlschlaeger, 86, of Giddings, Texas are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, December 17, 2019 at Martin Luther Lutheran Church in Giddings with Rev. John Waak officiating. Burial will follow in the Giddings City Cemetery. Visitation will be held on Monday, December 16, 2019 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Tuesday, December 17, 2019 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 a.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The family will be present for visitation Monday evening from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Kenneth Lee Ahlschlaeger was born on June 8, 1933 in Giddings, Texas to Benno and Annie Helen Louise (Fuchs) Ahlschlaeger. He was baptized on July 30, 1933 and was confirmed on April 11, 1948 at Martin Luther Lutheran Church in Giddings. Kenneth was drafted by the United States Army on October 14, 1953. He was released from active service on October 13, 1955 and was honorably discharged on September 30, 1961. He attended Blinn College on the GI Bill graduating with an Associate's degree in Business Administration. He was united in marriage to Waldine Schellberg on January 31, 1959 at Zion Lutheran Church in Houston, Texas by Rev. George Reck. He was a fencing contractor who owned Kenneth Ahlschlaeger Fencing. He served on the Lee County Historical Society board and was a very active member of Martin Luther Lutheran Church in Giddings. He enjoyed reminiscing about his military experience. He enjoyed watching football and

was a fan of the Dallas Cowboys, Giddings Buffaloes and the old Southwest conference teams. He loved living on their farm tending to his animals, gardening, tinkering and repairing things. He enjoyed going on road trips, going to antique farm equipment shows, and learning about the Amish way of life. Family and friends were important to Kenneth and he especially enjoyed watching his grandchildren excel in their activities.

Kenneth passed away the evening of Thursday, December 12, 2019 at Oakland Manor Nursing Center in Giddings.

He is preceded in death by his parents, Benno & Annie Ahlschlaeger; two sisters, Verlene Zbranek and Gladys Klinge, and one brother, Benno Ahlschlaeger Jr.

Kenneth is survived by his wife, Waldine of Giddings; three daughters, Diane Saegert and her husband Bill of Austin, Phyllis Pietsch and her husband, Tommy of Shiner, and Susan Ahlschlaeger of Austin; five grandchildren, Travis Saegert of Austin, Dylan Saegert of Austin, Courtney Siegel and her husband, Brett of Shiner, Jordan Pietsch of Shiner, and Tanner Pietsch of Houston; great grandchild, Sage Davis of Shiner; brother-in-law, Otto Schellberg and his wife, Glenna of Georgetown, as well as several nieces, nephews, cousins and extended family.

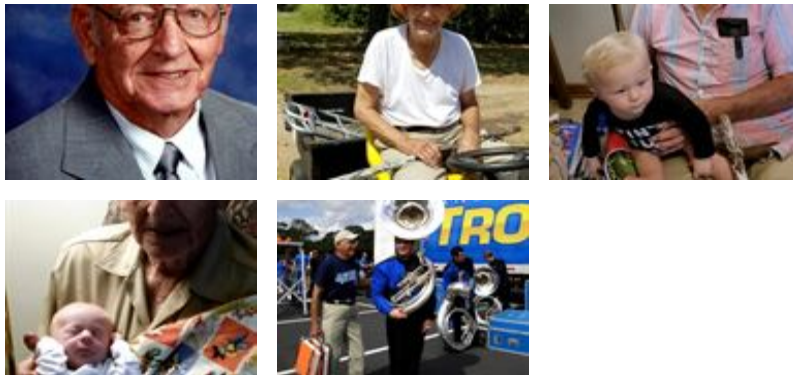
