Kenneth Wayne Foerster was born on January 29, 1951 in Giddings, Texas to Fred Henry and Lorene Annie (Boriack) Foerster. He was baptized on February 18, 1951 and confirmed on April 11, 1965 at St. John Lutheran Church in Lincoln, Texas. His confirmation verse was Romans 8:28 "And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose." Kenneth attended Texas A&M University and received his Master's in Engineering. He married Barbara Schulze on July 24, 1971 at St. John Lutheran Church in Lincoln, Texas. Kenneth worked at the Natural Resource Conservation Service as a civil engineer for the U.S. Department of Agriculture for many years. His faith life was very important, and he was an active member in the churches he was a member of. He served as treasurer at Trinity Lutheran Church in San Angelo and as assistant treasurer at St. John Lutheran Church in Lincoln. Kenneth also enjoyed being around people and was always willing to share his knowledge. He was a board member of the Lexington Log Cabin, played

baseball in Lincoln, loved playing 42, going fishing and golfing. Gardening was also a favorite of his. Family was always important, and he couldn't wait to spend time with his kids and grandkids.

Kenneth passed away the evening of Tuesday, July 7, 2020 at his home in Lexington.

He is preceded in death by his parents, Fred Foerster and Lorene Proske; brother, Brendon Proske; brother-in-law, Raymond Schulze, and his father-in-law and mother-in-law, Walter and Amanda Schulze.

Kenneth is survived by his wife, Barbara Foerster of Lexington; two children, Greg & Krista Foerster of New Hampshire and Kimberly & Zach McKinney of Damon; father, Lawrence Proske of Fedor; seven grandchildren, Juliana and Lucas Foerster of New Hampshire, William "Tripp", Cannon, Collin, Pierce, and Jett McKinney of Damon; sister, Barbara & Edward Markert of Lincoln, as well as several nieces, nephew, cousins and extended family.
