



Kenneth "Ken" Wayne Reimers

August 15, 1940 - January 5, 2018

Funeral services for Kenneth "Ken" Reimers, 77, of Houston, Texas, are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Friday, January 12, 2018 at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings with Ryan Grube officiating. In retirement, he worked for H & R Block preparing taxes for several years and had served on the Harris County Appraisal District's Appraisal Review Board for the past 8 years. Ken was a member of St. Ignatius of Loyola in Houston and the SPJST Lodge #88. He enjoyed watching sports and working on various projects around his house and his rental properties.

Ken passed away, surrounded by his family, on Friday, January 5, 2018 at the

St. Dominic Village in Houston.

He was preceded in death by his parents, W.R. & Leora Reimers.

Ken is survived by his son and daughter-in-law, Jason & Karen Reimers of Houston; his longtime wife, Maureen Reimers of Houston; two sisters and brothers-in-law, Jeanette & Henry Lindley of Houston and Barbara & Al Jaeger of Giddings; two nieces, Anita Lindley of Houston and Kim Walther & her husband, Tim of Giddings; one nephew, Jim Jaeger & his wife, Deanna of Giddings and several great nieces and great nephews.

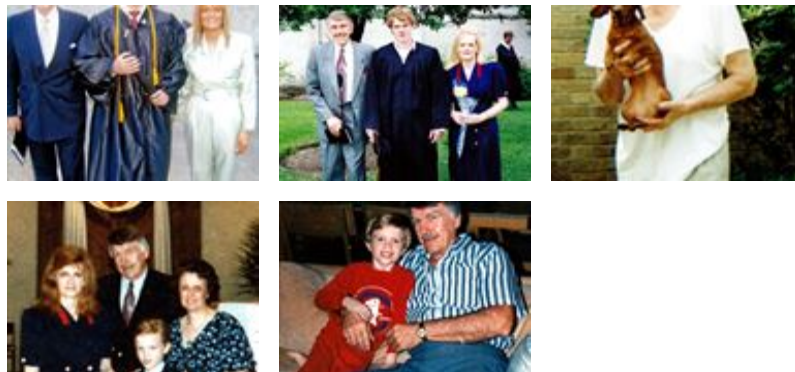
