



Kenneth Ray Weiser

June 5, 1931 - March 17, 2026

Funeral services for Ken Weiser, 94, of Northrup, Texas are scheduled for 2:00 p.m. on Sunday, March 22, 2026, at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin, Texas with Rev. John Schmidt officiating. Burial, with military honors provided by the Giddings American Legion York Post 276, will immediately follow in the church cemetery. Visitation will be held on Saturday, March 21, 2026, from 8:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Sunday, March 22, 2026, from 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The family will be present for visitation Saturday evening from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Kenneth Ray Weiser was born on June 5, 1931, in Thorndale, Texas to Herman Paul Weiser and Sidonia Emma (Kasper) Weiser. He was baptized on June 14, 1931 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Thorndale by Rev. F.H. Stelzer and confirmed on March 15, 1945, at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin by Rev. Herman Schmidt. His confirmation verse was Proverbs 23:26, "My son, give me your heart, and let your eyes observe my ways". After graduating from Giddings High School in 1949, Ken attended Nixon-Clay Business College in Austin. He served two years of active duty in the United States Army and an additional seven years in the National Guard. Ken and Ruby Lee Baack were united in marriage on October 20, 1962, at Martin Luther Lutheran Church in Giddings by Rev. Fred Mgebroff. After graduating from Nixon-Clay, Ken started his career in finance at Fidelity Bank in Austin and eventually became the bookkeeper for Walter Droemer Construction. In

1970, he started Ken Weiser Bookkeeping which he ran until his retirement. He was a member of the Lee County Go Texan Committee, was a lifetime committee member of the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo, was active in the Lutheran Laymen's League, served on the Texas District Board of the Lutheran Church Missouri Synod, was the area blood bank coordinator for many years, and was a member of the Giddings Rotary Club for over 50 years. Ken was a huge high school sports fan and an avid fan of the Giddings Buffaloes. Additionally, he served on the GISD school board for many years. He also enjoyed gardening, cutting wood and watching his kids (and later his grandkids) participate in numerous sporting events.

Ken passed away the morning of Tuesday, March 17, 2026, at his home in Northrup.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Herman and Sidonia Weiser; his sister and brother-in-law, Velma Jean and Glen Behrens; his brother-in-law, Gene Fritsche, and his parents-in-law, Archibald and Rosalie Baack.
