



## Kenneth Erwin Zoch

August 13, 1936 - January 28, 2015

Funeral services for Kenneth Zoch, 78 of Giddings, are scheduled for 2:00 p.m. on Friday, January 30, 2015 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings with Rev. Robert Tiner officiating. Burial will immediately follow in the Giddings City Cemetery. Kenneth Erwin Zoch was born on August 13, 1936 in Greens Creek, Texas to Edwin Wilhelm Herbert Zoch and Louise Adele (Mitschke) Zoch. He was baptized on August 23, 1936 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings by Rev. G.W. Fischer and confirmed on March 18, 1951 at Immanuel Lutheran Church. His confirmation verse was 2 Samuel 22:33, "God is my strength and power: and he maketh my way perfect". He was united in marriage to Gladys Laverne Teinert on June 11, 1960 at Immanuel Lutheran Church by Rev. Max Studtmann. Kenneth worked as a machinist at American Gear Supply Company in Houston for many years. After moving back to Giddings, he worked as a substation technician for Bluebonnet Electric. He enjoyed gardening, fishing, working on the farm, going to the coast and spending time with family. He will be remembered for his sense of humor, barbecued chicken and the love he had for his family.

Kenneth passed away unexpectedly during the early morning hours of Wednesday, January 28, 2015 at the Heart Hospital in Austin.
