



Kervin Earl Reuter

August 28, 1938 - May 30, 2017

Funeral services for Kervin Reuter, 78, of Giddings, Texas, are scheduled for 2:00 p.m. on Friday, June 2, 2017 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings with Rev. Chris Nietubicz officiating. 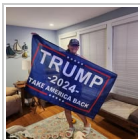
