



## Larry Glenn Lehmann

April 24, 1948 - November 4, 2023

Funeral services for Larry Lehmann, 75 of Dime Box, Texas, are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, November 8, 2023 at Trinity Lutheran Church in Old Dime Box, Texas with Rev. Bernard Schey officiating. Burial will follow in St. John Lutheran Cemetery in Dime Box. Visitation will be held on Tuesday, November 7, 2023 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Wednesday, November 8, 2023 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 a.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The family will be present for visitation Tuesday evening from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Larry Glenn Lehmann was born on April 24, 1948 at home on the family farm in Loebau, Texas. He was the son of Waldemar and Dorothy (Iselt) Lehmann. Larry was baptized and confirmed at Christ Lutheran Church in Loebau. He graduated from Dime Box High School with the class of 1967, most of whom are all still friends today. On August 22, 1970, Larry was united in marriage to Darleen Boriack at St. James Lutheran Church in Lexington, Texas. Larry owned and operated Lehmann's Welding in Dime Box since 1980 with the help of Jacob Beran. Many memories and projects were made while at the shop. He was an active member of the Dime Box Volunteer Fire Department for over 40 years and served as the Fire Chief for many years. He attended Trinity Lutheran Church in Old Dime Box where he had served in various positions and offices. Larry had also been a member of the Dime Box School Board and the Dime Box Lions Club, for which he created the 55-gallon barrel

train that was used for various fundraisers and festivals for many years. He spent many hours fishing, hunting and trapping when he was younger. Larry will be remembered as a hardworking, boisterous, and full of life man who could never get enough things done.

Larry passed away the evening of Saturday, November 4, 2023 at his home in Dime Box.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Waldemar and Dorothy Lehmann; his parents-in-law, Clarence and Edna Boriack; two brothers-in-law, Jerry Tallas and Alvin Klima, and his nephew, Andrew Boriack.
