Words I never got to hear from a father and it meant the world to me. I'm beyond sad to hear of his passing, he was genuinely a good man, he didn't take any shit from anyone, he was kind and caring. He was always on the right side and never wavered from his beliefs. We enjoyed talking politics, sports, and motorcycles. I'm going to miss him dearly, he will always be "Dad" to me. I love you Leland Lucas you will be greatly missed.*
