Leon Noack a lifelong resident of Rockdale was born February 11, 1930 in Rockdale to Ernest H. and Leona (Brockenbush) Noack. He was a graduate of Rockdale High School and Texas A&M University Class of 1952 with a degree in Animal Science. Over the years he had given three different scholarships to Texas A&M University. Leon was self-employed as a rancher raising Registered Herford breeder cattle and was in the oil business. On December 7, 1957, he and Billie Swanzy were married in Rockdale. He was a member of Peace Lutheran Church in Rockdale. Leon enjoyed being owner and breeder of race horse, dancing and being with his family.

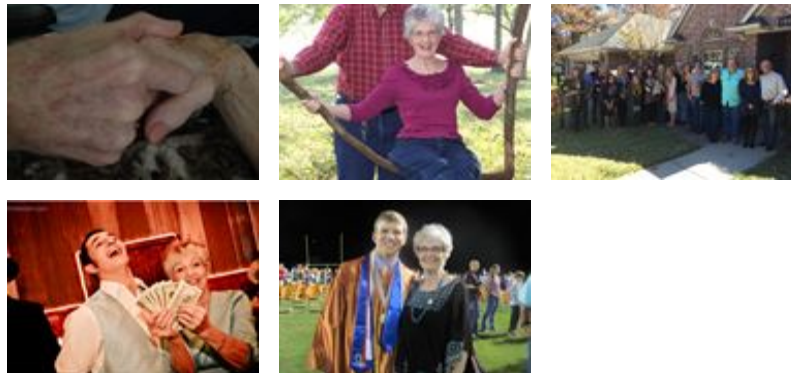
